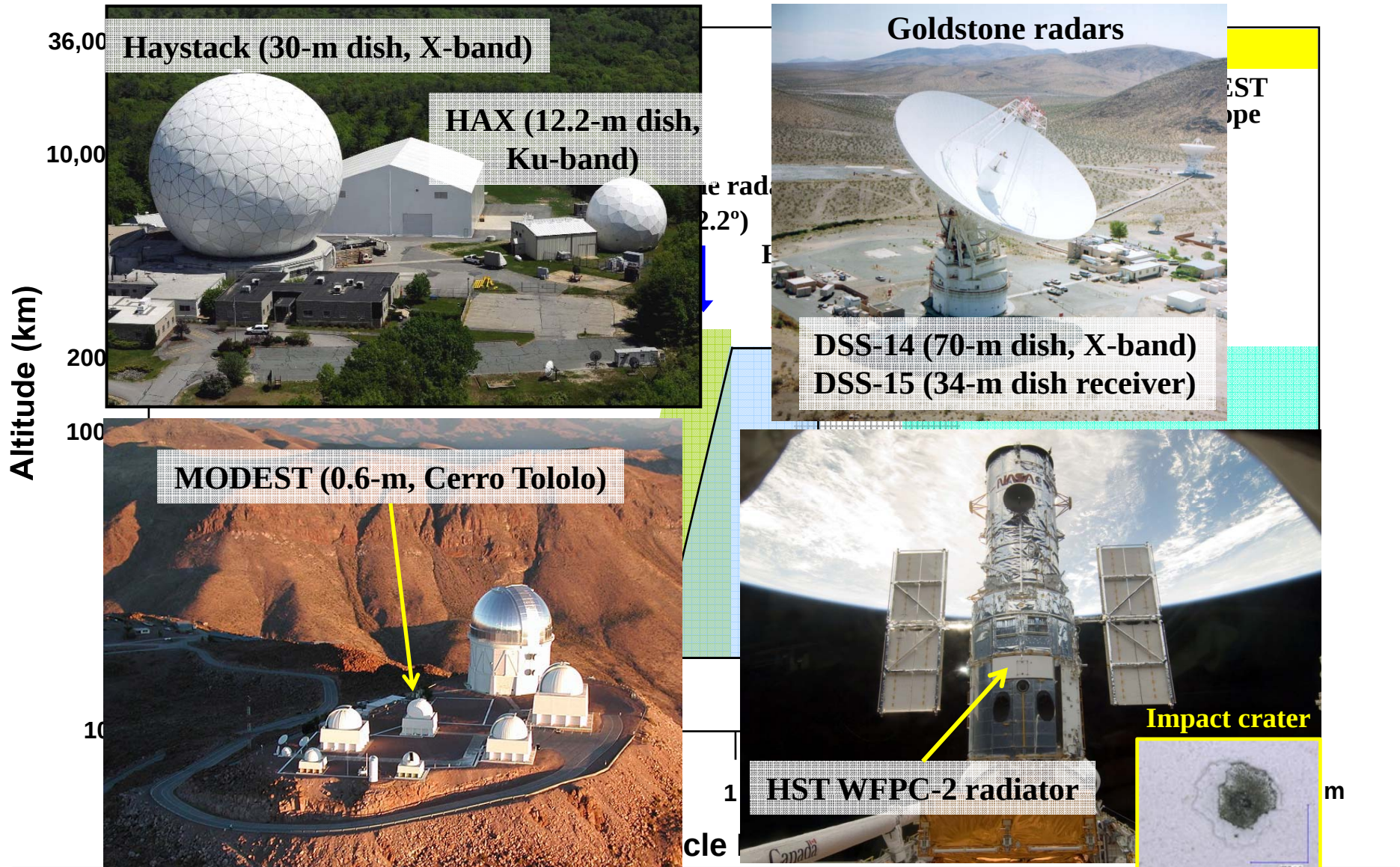


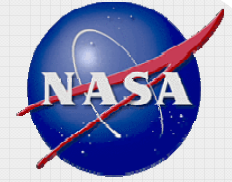
Current NASA Data Coverage* (1/2)





Current NASA Data Coverage (2/2)

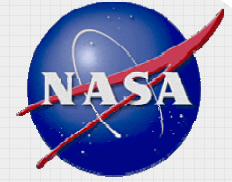




Future NASA Debris Telescope

- **NASA Meter Class Autonomous Telescope (MCAT)**
 - 1.3 m aperture, 0.96° field of view, f/4
 - Located at Kwajalein Atoll (9°N , 168°E)
 - Target detection limits
 - **GEO ~10 cm diameter (20.5 V-mag)**
 - Primary objectives
 - **GEO debris down to ~10 cm**
 - **LEO debris with low inclinations and high eccentricities**
 - **Simultaneous radar-optical observations**
 - Expected operations ~2012
