I. Overall Status:

1. All colored reproductions from S-190A and S-190B which will be used in the final data analysis have been received. Color reproductions from the Amps camera aboard NASA 925, from Mission #249, have not been delivered from the outside contractors. Difficulties in color balancing these data have slowed the final delivery.

All black and white negatives at the appropriate magnifications have been delivered, however, no reproductions will be made until after the analysis work has been done.

2. Work on lithologic and structural studies is continuing with good progress being made.
